## **Safety Corner**

As the days grow longer and the temperatures begin to rise, it's time to dust off our motorcycles and get back on the road. But before we hit the throttle, let's take a moment to ensure our safety and the safety of our riding buddies.

**Tire Inspection:** Check the tire pressure and tread depth. Cold weather can cause tires to lose pressure, and worn-out treads can be dangerous, especially on wet roads. Fluid Levels: Ensure that all fluid levels, including oil, coolant, and brake fluid, are topped up to the recommended levels. Cold weather can cause fluids to thicken or

Battery Health: Cold temperatures can drain motorcycle batteries. Check the battery's charge and condition. Charge it if necessary, or consider replacing it if it's too weak

Brake Check: Test your brakes to make sure they are working properly. Ensure that brake pads and discs are in good condition.

Lights and Signals: Verify that all lights and turn signals are functioning correctly. This is crucial for visibility on the road, especially during dawn, dusk, or nighttime

Gear Inspection: Inspect your riding gear, including your helmet, gloves, jacket, and
