- Sunday 17 September Silverdale to Whinchester Bay 392 miles.
- Monday 18 September Winchester Bay to Fort Bragg, CA 367 miles.
- Tuesday 19 September Fort Bragg to Sonora, CA 333 miles.
- Wednesday 20 September Sonora to Reno, NV 260 miles.
- Thursday 21 September Ride around Lake Tahoe then to Carson City and Virginia City, returning to Reno that same night.
- Friday 22 September Rest day to check out all the vendors, entertainment, and day rides you might arrange on your own.
- Saturday 23 September Depart Reno to Bend OR. 415 miles.
- Sunday 24 September Bend to Silverdale, WA 400 miles.
